**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR RESOLUTION OF ELECTRICITY SUPPLY
ISSUE IN BUKURUNGO TC**

I am writing to bring to your attention a pressing issue affecting the residents of Bukurungo Town Council, specifically concerning the stalled electricity project that was contracted in 2016/2017.

The project aimed to generate electricity from maize cobs and included the installation of poles and wires. Unfortunately, despite the initial progress, the connection to electricity for the community has not been completed. As a result, the residents are left with the infrastructure in place but without access to electricity.

In Bukurungo Town Council, there are four wards, two landing sites, a government health center, a secondary school, and three primary schools. The presence of electricity would greatly benefit these institutions in several ways:

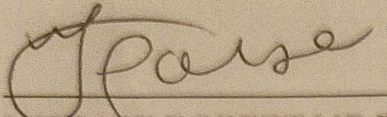
1. ***Government Health Center***: Reliable electricity would enable the health center to power essential medical equipment, improve patient care, and maintain necessary refrigeration for medicines and vaccines.
2. ***Secondary and Primary Schools***: Access to electricity would facilitate learning through the use of modern educational tools such as computers and projectors. It would also allow for extended study hours, thereby improving educational outcomes for the students.
3. ***Landing Sites***: Electrification would support local businesses through improved operations and facilities, encouraging economic growth in the area.

There is a growing concern among the community that the current state of the poles and wires may lead to vandalism, which would further jeopardize the potential for future electricity access. Therefore, we kindly urge your good office to intervene and find a solution that can restore the connection and bring electricity to Bukurungo.

Your support in addressing this matter will have a significant positive impact on the livelihoods of the residents and the overall development of the area.
